WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT FROM YOU AND HOW?

We only collect and process the following types of information about you:

- When you register for a Cork Sports Partnership event via email, phone or online through our online registration provider;
- If you ask us to keep in touch with you;

- If you contact us (for example, by phone, email or otherwise) to find out more about a sport or physical activity opportunity.

The personal information you give us may include your first and surname, gender, date of birth, email address, phone number, address, medical conditions, in case of emergency contact details and any other information that you consider necessary to provide us with.

media platforms to utilise a number of services without providing any personal information to CSP. In general, Cork Sports Partnership does not collect personal information you when you visit these sites.

For certain sections of Cork Sports Partnership's website, where user's require, seek or sign up to further information, personal information is collected by CSP in order to reply to specific queries you make. Unless specified by you, your personal information will only be used for the duration that your specific Cork Sports Partnership query is active.

Personal information, for the purposes of this Privacy Statement relates to information outlined above that can identify any individual including name, address, contact details. Cork Sports Partnership may use the above personal data held about you for the following purposes (purposes for which we need your consent are marked *):

- To carry out obligations arising from any contracts entered between you and us and to provide you with information on sport and physical activity that you request from us.
- To help us identify you and previous engagements you have had with us;
- To send you updates and marketing content.*
- To manage data collected via our website;
- To provide other services requested by you, as described when we collect the data;
- To address any enquiries, correspondence, concerns or complaints you have raised;
- To make suggestions and recommendations to you about other programmes, events, workshops or initiatives that may be of interest to you*.

WHAT IS THE LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING YOUR DATA?

There are currently a number of legal basis for Cork Sports Partnership to process your personal data. These include; Contractual Necessity, Unambiguous Consent and Legitimate Interest.

Contractual Necessity:

Contractual Necessity is where we use personal information provided to process the appropriate steps of a contract with you for an activity of Cork Sports Partnership and/or third party provider. An example of this would be where you register online to take part in an event offered by Cork Sports Partnership. Cork Sports Partnership will need to process your personal information in order to fulfill the contractual obligation of the event or to provide support services for that specific event.

Similarly, Cork Sports Partnership works with a number of different third party providers to provide sport and physical activity opportunities to the people of Cork and beyond. It is necessary for us to share your personal information with these third party providers for the purpose of the programme, event, workshop or initiative you have signed up to take part in.

Legitimate Interest:

Another example of where Cork Sports Partnership collects your personal data is where we have a legitimate interest to use your data, provided that proper care is taken in relation to your rights. This would include:

- To ensure that we organise our database efficiently and understand how our stakeholders use our website, social media platforms and engage with our marketing campaigns. This will help us to better ensure we continue to improve our online/offline tools to better cater for all our stakeholders.
- To carry out analysis of your data as this helps us understand our stakeholders better, who they are and how they interact with Cork Sports Partnership.
- To ensure that you know about any changes to the website or the terms of this Privacy Policy.

Cork Sports Partnership only provides you with information about programmes, events, workshops, initiatives and updates, if you have given us your consent to do so. Similarly, Cork Sports Partnership can provide you with customised online advertising should you wish to opt in to receiving such advertising online.

Cork Sports Partnership operates an opt in policy for marketing updates at the time of registration for a Cork Sports Partnership activity or through the sign up form on the Cork Sports Partnership website. If you would like to sign up over the phone, a member of the Cork Sports Partnership team can facilitate this for you. You can unsubscribe to these updates at any time by clicking the unsubscribe link at the bottom of any email or by contacting the Cork Sports Partnership office.

Cork Sports Partnership will ask if you would like us to send you these marketing messages by ticking an appropriate opt in box at the relevant activation point. This is through the following sources:

- If you submit a request to a member of the Cork Sports Partnership team over the phone;
- If you Email a request to be added to a Cork Sports Partnership newsletter;
- Online registration for a Cork Sports Partnership supported event, programme, workshop or initiative;
- Attendance at a Cork Sports partnership event, programme, workshop or initiative;

WHO WILL WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA WITH?

- **Third Party Providers:** We only share your personal information with third party providers who are delivering programmes, events, workshops & initiatives in collaboration or on behalf of Cork Sports Partnership. This information will only be used for the duration of the programme unless you specify otherwise and opt in to additional opportunities during the activity.
- **Service Providers:** Cork Sports Partnership IT services, sub-contractors and business partners for the performance of any contract we enter into with you.
- **Analytics & Search Engine Providers:** Analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of the Website;
- **Law Enforcement:** Law enforcement or regulatory agencies, or authorised third parties, in response to a verified request relating to a criminal investigation or alleged illegal activity.
- **Other:** Other business entities, should we plan to merge with or be acquired by that business entity. Should such a combination occur, we will require that the new combined entity follow this Privacy Policy with respect to your data.

WHAT ARE COOKIES & WHY WE USE THEM?
